My Will is that my Estate which consists of a negro
woman Presilla and of some household furniture
shall be appraised and Stated by two men chosen
by my children for that purpose according to
its true Value My will is that my youngest son
John shall have the said negro woman Presilla
and my household furniture in his possession and
one half of the value of the same as his property
the other half is to be divided equally among my
other children that is William Barton Basil Thomas
Greenbury Elmona Sarah Lucy and Eda hereby
utterly revoke and disannull all and every former
Testaments Wills Legacies Bequestes by me before
in any wife made & bequeathed ratifying and
confirming this and no other to be my last Will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand, and seal this tenth Day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred & ninety

 and assigns forever Five Negroes whose
 names and ages are as follows Viz: 1st a
 woman named Diny aged thirty two years
 2^d a boy named Anthony aged thirteen years
 3^d a girl named Sarah aged nine years
 4th a girl named Delpha aged six years
 5th a boy named Jeffery aged three years

to have and to hold unto the said John Paddy coast
 his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
 warrant & defend said Negroes with
 all their Increase unto the said John
 Paddy coast against the lawful claims of all
 persons whatsoever In Testimony whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and seal and
 at the same time have delivered said Negroes
 unto the said John Paddy coast this fifth Day of
 November in the year of our Lord One
 thousand seven hundred & twenty one.
