July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty six  
make & publish this my last will & testament in manner  
following, that is to say,

First. I will my soul to God who gave it & my body to be buried in  
a decent manner.

Second. I give & bequeath to each of my brothers & sisters namely as follows

and Margaret Peter one dollar. also one dollar to the heirs of Christian

Third. I give & bequeath to Philip Lethenour my black woman named  
Alice & one bed & furniture & one stand of curtains & one set of  
window curtains & one red kiser & one wheel & what gear debts in  
hand & all my wearing clothes & one set of traps & panes & one  
set of plates to him the said Philip Lethenour to have & to hold  
the said black woman forever.

Fourth. I give & bequeath to Frederic Gambold a certain note which I  
hold on said Gambold for one hundred & fifty Dollars given the  
30th December 1835 with various credits by him paying ten Dollars  
to my Exec for John Gambold's oldest son

Fifth. I give & bequeath to John Gambold ~~five~~ <sup>ten</sup> Dollars ~~within~~ Dollars.

Sixth. I give & bequeath to John Gambold second son ten Dollars.

Seventh. I give & bequeath to Christian Tipton one house clock.

Eighth. I give & bequeath to Samuel Reed daughter Katherine four Dollars.

Ninth. I give & bequeath to Christina Lunnice five Dollars.

Tenth. I give & bequeath to the treasure of the Freirian Church five Dollars.

Eleventh. I will & bequeath the balance of my Estate if any shall remain  
after making the above distribution to Frederic Gambold & John  
Gambold to be divided equally alike.

And I herein make & ordain my worthy friend William Linsen  
Executor of this my last will & testament for him to collect all  
my debts & due me by note or otherwise & pay all my just  
debts & to make sale of all my property not herein bequeathed.
