Fourth. Rufus Scurran I give a negro boy named John & the half of the hundred acre tract of land below & resigning my old plantation to be sold & the other half to James Scurran.

Further it is my will that after my death all my stock of every description & all my household & kitchen furniture of every description (except two beds & furniture of mine & Elizabeth Welch one & the other to be left Welch my two grand daughters) together with all bonds & debts due me to wit: one of James Welch a bond for three hundred dollars & three hundred dollars in cash in Welch's care, all the above to wit, the stock & household & kitchen furniture except the two beds above named, to be sold & the money arising from the sale thereof & the money in James Welch's care & the bond upon said Welch collected & all these moneys equally divided among my heirs. Further I appoint James Welch guardian for my son to conduct his business fairly & justly.

And lastly I hereby make & assign my trusty friend James Davidson
& William A. Mitchell my Executors to this my last will & testament.

The balance of the perishable part of my Estate to be sold on a credit of twelve months & the proceeds of the sale to be equally divided among the rest of my children with the balance of my Land which is to be laid off in equal lots & valued by two men chosen by the executors & thus the five following children draw an equal part, namely, my beloved daughter Nancy Larimons bodily living is to draw her part my beloved son James T. my beloved daughter Margaret bodily living is to draw her part, my beloved son John F. my beloved daughter Mary McAnally.

And I hereby make & ordain my worthy friends James T. Wright & Jesse McAnally Executors of this my last will & testament. In witness whereof I the said John Wright have to this my last will & testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written —
