The other half of the money arising out of the sale of my Estate after my debts are paid shall be paid by my executors within two years after my decease to my dear & beloved wife Mary to be her sole property for ever. I give & bequeath unto my dear & beloved wife Mary all my household furniture all my bedding & one cow for her own use as & properly for ever. Lastly I do now appoint my beloved friends Jacob Lagerauer sen. & John Clapp as my executors to this my last will & testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 19th day of Jan 1808.

I Thomas East Sen. of Stokes County State of North Carolina being weak in body but of good and perfect mind & memory & understanding and not knowing the appointed hour when to die do hereunto make & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say First I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my executors not doubting but to have a happy resurrection. And as touching my worldly estate and effects I give & bequeath & dispose of the same in manner & form following First it is my will that my just debts & funeral expenses be duly paid out of my estate by my executors hereafter named & also all my outstanding debts due me to be collected by them Secondly I give & bequeath to the Children of my beloved daughter Cate one negro girl named Kate with her increase also one negro boy named Jim son of old Jim Hall but nevertheless it is my will that my said daughter Cate shall have the use & possession of said negro during her natural life and after her decease the said Children of her body shall have the said negro with the increase of the girl as their own property they & their heirs forever - Thirdly I give & bequeath to the Children of my daughter Elizabeth two negro girls one named Nancy & the other named Sally (daughters of old Jim Hall) & their increase on the same conditions above mentioned Fourthly I give & bequeath to the Children of my daughter Nancy three negro boys Jim Sally his wife & Rebecca their daughter & their increase (& their property shall go with him) on the same conditions above mentioned & my said three daughters shall enjoy the possession & benefit of the said negroes & their increase during their natural life and after their decease the Children of their body & their heirs to be the proprietors of the said negroes & their increase It is also my will that my daughter Nancy should have my negro girl named Luke daughter of Jim Hall & of

to my son Thomas East just the other third to my daughter

Fourthly. I give & bequeath to my son Thomas East one
negro woman named Hannah and all her natural
increase also one negro boy named Enock together
with one Wagon and all my blacksmith Tools to
him & his heirs forever Also I give & bequeath to
my said son Thomas East The tract of land
on which I now live containing four hundred
acres be the same more or less with all the appurtenances
to him & his heirs forever

Fifthly. I give & bequeath to my two Grand sons Simeon
Brown & Thomas East Brown Two hundred acres of
land be the same more or less lying on the hollow
road adjoining the above well? tract to my son
Thomas East the division line between them shall
begin at Abel Edwards's corner pine and pine knot
corner on the east side of the hollow road near
the head of the Meeting house Spring thence running
a south Course across said road to a black oak
a corner of Samuel Bullock's land on the east side of
Cabbie run branch to thence & thence his heirs forever

Sixthly. It is also my will, that my old negro
woman by the name of Fanny should have her
house & lot on which she now lives with all her
property she has to have & to hold and dispose
of as she pleases & she to be in the care of my
executors.

It is also my will that after my death that all
my household & Kitchen Furniture be equally
divided between my three Daughters of which
I give to them & their heirs forever

Also I give & bequeath to my three daughters all
my stocks of every kind to be equally divided between
them to them & their heirs forever. I also give to
my grandson Thomas Edwards son of Abel Edwards
my shot Gun It is also my will & desire (that if it
is please God to run on me from this world) before
the Commencement of the year that the Crop upon
land shall be finished by the hands engaged
therein & when finished to be equally divided
amongst my four Children

I do hereby Appoint my son Thomas or Edgell Henry
Spencer Howard my sole & sole Executor of this my
last will & Testament.
