of Wake of North Carolina a planter being sickly &
weak in body but in perfect mind & memory thank
be given unto God calling unto mind the mortality of
my body do make & ordain this my last will &
testament in manner following. I recommend my
soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it
& my body I recommend to the earth to be buried
in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my
Executors & as touching such worldly estate where-
with it has pleased God to bless me in this life I
give devise & dispose of the same in the following
manner & forms.

First I give & bequeath to Elizabeth my beloved
wife one feather bed & furniture & the old bay

64 Mary & her saddle & she is to be maintained on the plantation & new life on as long as she remains my widow secondly I give unto my first born son John the young boy Mary.

Thirdly is my will that my sons John Thomas Solomon & William is to have my land & tenements containing two hundred & twenty acres for them their heirs & assigns forever to be equally divided between them my four sons when my youngest son William is of age or twenty one years old.

Fourthly I give to my Daughters Rachel & Milly one feather bed with furniture & one new apron
Fifthly I ordain that all my Debt is to be paid out of all my estate after my decease & all my things due to me is to be collected by my executor & put out upon Interest untill my youngest son William is of age then the half of said money is to be divided between my sons John Thomas Solomon & William & the other half to my Daughters Rachel & Milly.

Also in this my will that the rest of my horses and my cattle dogs and houses & plantation furniture is to be left for the use of the families.

I also constitute make & ordain my wife Elizabeth & my Brother David Hunter the sole executors of this my last will & testament And I do hereby

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Wholy disallow and revoke all former Testament with legacies and executors Ratifying and confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty second day of February one thousand eight hundred & five.

I John a member of the family of Stokes State of North Carolina do hereby make my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say.

1st After the payment of my last Debt I give to my wife Mary Ann forty Dollars in money two cows also my Bed & trunk & proportionate share of the Meat that shall be killed & corn to support her for the present year & also her stock to be without one of the present crop together with all the property & furniture thereof that she brought here & also the use of a Negro man called Adam for the term of three years at the expiration of which time my will & desire is to either sell or hire as convenient as may be to her wife.
