2d. I also give unto my sons Joshua & John & if my wife
should be delivered of a son child within nine months
from the date hereof the land is to be equally divided between
the three sons & if a daughter my two sons Joshua & John are
to pay each day to the twenty dollars after they arrive to age
of twenty one

3d. I will my wife Anna one more year pickled cow
also two sheep & twelve head of hogs all the house hold & kitchen
furniture & the farming utensils Also I give to my son Joshua
One rifle gun —

4th. I will that the balance of my personal property be
sold and the money arising from the sale thereof be applied
to the payment for schooling my children

5th I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend Abram Parker
Executor of this my last Will & Testament in witness whereof I the
said Thomas Jones have to this my last will & testament set my
hand and seal the day and year above written
