 give to the said Bole Sr. one Wagon and three beds of
 furniture one horse & 2 dogs Eight head of cattle and all my
 working tools such as saws, shovels, hoes & plows. I give to my beloved
 friend Mary Bole to be freely enjoyed by him for ever I ordain
 this to be my last will and testament by him freely to be
 proposed and enjoyed and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke
 and disannul all and any other former testaments wills
 Legacies Bequests & Executors by me in any way before mentioned
 written and Bequeathed ratifying & confirming this to be my
 last will and testament in no other in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 2nd day of May
 A.D. 1831 I thereby appoint Alexander Bole Sr. my Executor of
 my last will and testament

 the property that is remaining to be balance of two
 for holding and to be equally divided between
 my three daughters namely Lydia and Rebecca in a
 share and they to take the property at the
 valuation and I do hereby appoint my son Benjamin
 Kelly Executor of this my last will and testament
 hereby making all for him only and a testament
 my son Benjamin Kelly made while he was of age
 his wife set my hand and seal this 2nd day of
