 sons & my two Daughters Martha Noddy
 & Judith Brooks I give & bequeath all the
 remainder of what we may be found
 of mine (not before disposed of) equally
 amongst them alike to them & their heirs
 forever to be divided equally amongst
 them at their discretion A.D. The omission
 to my beloved wife Cicila of half a dozen
 better places on better dish & on better
 Darn is here put in

Lastly I constitute & ordain & appoint
 my two sons Andrew Johnson & William
 Johnson jointly & severally Executors of this
 my last will & Testament Dated in
 Stokes County this twenty fourth day of
 the fourth month (called April) in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven

 Stephen Fontana & Elizabeth Fulp wife of

 & to my wife I give the last & furniture to be given

mind the mortality of my body & knowing that I
am appointed for all men once to die do make
ordain & appoint & as by these presents make Con-
stitute ordain & appoint this my last will & Testament
in manner & form as follows

First I will that all my just debts shall be
paid out of my estate.

Secondly I leave to my beloved wife Frances
during her natural life & widowhood all my real
both real & personal and after her death to be sold
at public sale to the highest bidder & the money
arising therefrom to be equally divided amongst my
surviving children but in case any of them should
die without lawful issue that their part to return
into the Estate again & be divided as above mentioned.

I also will that my said wife shall have the power
to give up to any of my children whose majority may
require it such part of said Estate as she shall
think proper & most convenient & that to be approved
by two indifferent men of good fame.

I will that my grandson James Matthews shall
have five pounds paid out on him in schooling &
be found more given him out of my estate after
my wife's death.

lastly I do by these presents constitute order &
appoint my beloved wife Frances executrix &
my son James executor to this my last will &
Testament.
