

In the name of God Amen I William Boyles of the County of Hoke & State of North Carolina being old senile and knowing it is appointed unto all men once to die make & publish this my last will & testament. First I will say what worldly effects I have placed to be disposed of with I will bequeath as follows. My negro girl Mary I give & bequeath to my son William Boyles my negro woman Betty & her youngest child & Sarah to my daughter Sally who is intermarried with John Henry my negro girl Keller I give & bequeath unto my daughter Betty who is intermarried with Frederick Francis. And my negro girl Esther I gave & bequeath to my daughter Nancy who is intermarried with Joseph Boyles & my negro fellow Sam I gave & bequeath to my son Joel. I have some idea of disposing Sam for another negro if I do then my son Joel is to have the negro & get for him. I will that my Executors all be my personal property consisting of my stock of all kinds again to be sold after my decease as practicable and pay all my just debts which are due. I will that all my lands be sold by my Executors in not less than 12 months after my death on a credit of two years and the proceeds thereof as well as all my ready money & debts to be collected which I have owing to me & to be equally divided between my children hereinafter named except such sum as I intend giving to the children of my two deceased sons Thomas Boyles & James Boyles. I have unto my son Thomas children if he has any living one hundred dollars among them all for the purpose of educating them. I also gave to the children of my son James if he has any living one hundred dollars among them all for the purpose of educating them. Which I will that my Executors pay them or their lawful agent out of my Estate. I will that all the proceeds of my Estate be equally divided among my five children William Boyles, Betty Francis, Sally Francis, Nancy Boyles and Joel Boyles. I want my lands rented the first year after my decease so my children who live in Alabama may have notice of the sale of my lands. All the proceeds of my two tracts of land & the due me ready money &c. proceeds of all my personal property except the above said to the children of my sons Thomas & James to be equally divided to a cent between my five children above mentioned & keeping all other former wills & testaments by me made
