to him and to hold the said Slave
with her increase to him his heirs and
assigns forever And I do by these presents
warrant and defend her the said Negro
Doll from all persons laying any Lawful
claim to the said William Davis his
heirs and assigns forever Given under my
hand the 8th Day of May anno: 1791

of forty one pounds current money in hand
paid by Pleasant Henderson of Rockingham
County State aforesaid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have bargained
sold and delivered and by these presents
do bargain sell and deliver to the said
Pleasant Henderson a certain Negro
Slave commonly known & called by the
name of Ned, which Negro man Slave
Ned to the said Pleasant Henderson
his heirs and assigns forever Thuly warrant
and defend against myself my heirs or the
just claim of all persons whomsoever

 first of All I give and recommend my soul
 unto the hand of Almighty God that gave it
 and my body I recommend to the earth
 to be buried in a decent Christian burial
 at the direction of my Executors nothing
 doubting but at the general resurrection
 I shall receive the same again by the mighty
 power of God and as touching such worldly
 estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless
 me in this life I give devise and dispose
 of the same in the following manner and
 form — First of All
 I give unto my well beloved wife Delinda
 Chandler whom I likewise constitute make
 and ordain the sole executrix of this my
 last will and testament all and singular

my lands Mesuages and tenements
by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed
and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke
and annul all and every other former

by me in any wise before named and
