My funeral Expenses Physican Expenses and all other Expenses
shall be paid out of the principal sum which I have on Interest the
remaining part which may be left of the said Principal sum
I have and bequeath unto Charles Cooper and Selia Cooper above
named to be divided among them Equally —

unto the rest and residue of my Estate which is here little & trifling
I have and bequeath unto Mary Smith & Dorothy Warner for their
children and also intend to have unto Maria Polk Charles as
before me at their direction —

And I hereby now make and appoint my trusty friend Abraham
Peters son of Polk aforesaid Executor of this my last will and
Testament —
