- 1<sup>o</sup> It is my will that all my just debts be paid
- 2<sup>o</sup> It is my will that all my property be kept together under the care and control of my wife for the benefit of all the children who remain with her and especially to enable her to raise my younger children.
- 3<sup>o</sup> It is also my wish, that if my wife can find a piece of land better suited to enable her to raise the younger children, I hereby empower her to sell my present home and buy another for to be held by her for the benefit of herself and all the children until the youngest child becomes of age and then to be equally divided between them my wife having dower in the land she now lives upon, or may buy, in testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of December 1858
