 shall be sold after the death of my wife

 five Shillings Sterling
 Sixthly I bequeath to my beloved daughter Betty Babbitt
 five Shillings Sterling

Verily I will that the remaining part of the money arising
 from the sale be equally divided between my other sons
 & heirs namely Philip Dean, John Dean, Joseph Dean
 William Dean Betty Pegram & Ezra Cummings and
 Nancy Williamson

the Plantation I now live on containing three
hundred acres more or less the said William Hunter
is to maintain me and my wife our life time &
after our deaths to have the said plantation with
all the working tools that is on it.
