I Martin Ebert of Stokes County in the state of North Carolina being weak in body, but of perfect mind & memory do make this date the day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & seven this my last will & Testament in manner following

First I will that my son Martin shall pay a debt of One hundred & twenty five dollars which I owe to Cornelius Sanders estate and all interest thereon for which he shall have all that tract of land whereon he now lives as his sole property forever

Secondly I will that my wife Hannah shall remain living on my present plantation whereon I now live during her widowhood with my son John my daughter Elizabeth and my wife shall be both sufficiently maintained out of said plantation during as aforesaid & shall keep slaves as necessary.

Thirdly I will that my son John shall pay the residue of my debts for which he shall have all that tract of land whereon I now live besides as much of the personal estate as can at present be spared as his sole property forever.

Fourthly I will that my three daughters Christiane Elizabeth & Maria shall have that tract of land of about thirty acres adjoining Pine Hills land to be divided among them three equally as their sole property forever

Fifthly I will that if any of my personal estate in possession of my wife at her removal or her death the same shall be divided in equal parts among her and my aforesaid children than & than alike

I constitute and appoint my trusty friends Henry Phipps and my wife executors of this my last will & Testament

I William Martin Jun^r of Stokes County State of North Carolina being in a low & declining state of health tho' of sound & disposing mind & memory do make for aain this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all former wills whatever.

In the first place after my just debts are paid & my body decently buried at the discretion of my executors herein after mentioned I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Rachel Martin

the tract of land whereon I now live containing
 two hundred & seven acres also five Negroes to wit
 Will Patt Zelpha Lucy & little Patt. for he support
 during his Natural life also one Choice bed & 4
 furniture also two Horns viz: the black man
 the youngest Calt & two Choice Cows and
 all my household furniture & plantation tools
 except such part thereof as is herein otherwise
 disposed of I give unto my beloved daughter
 Nancy Fullin two negroes to wit Phoebe and
 Hannah now in her possession along on her
 furniture Two Cows all now in her possession
 I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah Childs
 two Negroes Edy & Phillis also one bed & furniture
 & one horse called whig & one cow & calf now in
 her possession. I give & bequeath unto my beloved
 daughter Susanna Childs Martin five negroes
 to wit Delpha & her four children Charlotte John
 Jany & May & then increase & one feather bed
 & furniture & one boy man called Ball.
 I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sincy
 Clark two Negroes viz: Judith & Mory & one
 man called Bigger one feather bed & furniture
 & one Cow now in her possession. - I give & bequeath
 unto my beloved daughter Polly Moor three
 negroes viz: Mitty the two children Charles &
 little will one feather bed & furniture now in
 possession. I give & bequeath unto my beloved son
 William Martin two Negroes viz: Lewis & Pat.
 daughter of old Pat. Lewis is now in his possession
 & two hundred acres of land adjoining the land
 whereon I now live being the land I bought
 of Jsh Meredith also one bed & furniture

and one horse called Comet the horse now in
 possession. I give & bequeath unto my beloved son
 Samuel Martin the tract of land whereon I now
 live containing two hundred & seven acres after the
 death of his mother also two Negroes viz: Nathan
 & Isaac one cowd Horn called Snap & one
 fifth part of my present Crop of Corn & Tobacco
 & one bed & furniture. -

And after my wife's death the residue of my
 Estate to be equally divided between part of
 my Children viz: Nancy Fullin Sarah Childs
 Sincy Clark William Martin Polly Moor
 & Samuel Martin.

And lastly I do hereby appoint William
 Martin Samuel Martin & William Moore
 my executors to this my last will & testament
 In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & seal this 9th day of January 1788.
