my just debts and also to collect all my out
standing debts.

Star have to this my last will & testament

present of sound & perfect mind & memory
albeit afflicted with bodily infirmities & declining
into mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that
it is appointed for all the human race once to
die do this ninth day of October in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & Ten
make & publish this my last will & testament
that is to say principally first of all I recommend
my soul into the hands of Almighty God and
my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
Burial at the discretion of my executors & according
such Worsh Estate wherewith it has pleased God
to bless me with in this life & give devise & dispose
of the same in the manner following

First I give & bequeath unto my dear wife Anna
one negro girl named Lucy for during
my wifes natural life then said negro to

136 her increase if she should have any to be
equally divided according to Valuation between
my four Children viz to John Martin his son
Martin Lewis & Martin Tilley Reddick.

and the remainder of my slaves it is
my will and desire that they be equally
divided among & between my four Children
aforesaid according to Valuation excepting that
my old Negroe woman Francy is not
to be valued to any of them but shall
be at liberty to choose for herself which
of my Children she will live with who
shall have her without price. further
I will and desire that my wife Eleanor shall
have my black Man & two bed & furniture
and to give unto my son Lewis my Bone-jilly
one bed and parriculer and one Cow &
Calf and that my wife have one Cow
& Calf also. & the balanced of my estate both
real and personal not devised above &
is my will & desire that it be equally divided
than & than alike after paying my just debts
between my wife Eleanor & four Children
aforesaid excepting that my son Lewis shall
have & receive Twenty five Dollars more in
his share than any one of the others.
Further it is my will & desire that none of
my heirs shall be called to account for any
thing I have heretofore given them excepting
that if my son in law David Reddick

should raise an action against my estate
then and in that case he shall be called to
account for an amount which I have against
him & not otherwise.

(And I make & ordain my wife Eleanor
my son John Martin & Charles Banner my
two of them Executrix of this my last will and
testament in Witness whereof I the said William
Martin have set my last will & testamant in
my hand & seal the day & year first above written
Signed sealed published & declared by the said William
Martin the testator as the his
last will & testament in presence
of as who are present at the
beginning & sealing thereof)
