hands to be eachly divid between them to them & their heirs
forever

Now I give one negro wench named Fells to my Daughter
Moley Joyce & what cash is in hand and one horse
to them & their heirs forever

Now I give Elizabeth Joyce my Shrubberies & Tree buttons
in token of remembrance forever

I constitute & appoint Samuel Clark a trustee to this
my last Will & Testament this first day of October 1795
