Impromis I will that all my debts and funeral Charges be paid and Discharged by my Executors here in After named.

Impromis My will and Desire is that the place wherein I now live be sold and the money thence arising be at the Disposal of my wife for the Bringing up and Educating my small Children and that my family move to another place near to the former, Down the same Branch.

Impromis I Give unto my loving wife Hannah Jones all my Estate real & personal during her Natural life or Widowhood, But in case my wife do marry or when she shall Die I Give as follows

Impromis To my Daughter Elizabeth Jones five Shillings Sterling. To my Son Abraham Jones the place or Plantation where I desire my Family to move. And the rest of my Estate I Give to be Equally divided among my five Children (viz) Mary Jones Anna Jones, Joseph Jones, Jonathan Jones & Lewis Jones.

Lastly I do constitute and appoint my wife Hannah Jones & my Neighbour
Stephen Clayton Int Executors to this my last Will and Testament
Signed with my hand and sealed with my seal this fourteenth
Day of February) one thousand seven hundred, and seventy seven
