I Benjamin Bowles of Hanover County Virginia being weak in Body but of a Perfect Memory do make and Constitute this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (to wit) I give my Body to the ground from whence it came my Soul to the god that gave it As to what worldly Estate the Lord has Bestow'd me with I dispose as follows Item I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Bowles two hundred Acres of Land lying in Kentucky to him his Heirs and Assigns forever Item I give to my Brother John Bowles one thousand Acres of Land lying in Kentucky also a Negro Fellow named Lewis to him his Heirs and Assigns forever Item I give to my Sister Mary Ford five hundred Acres of Land lying in Kentucky also a Negro Boy named John to her and her Heirs and Assigns forever Item I give to my Sister Tanny Burward one negro wench named Silca to her and her Heirs and Assigns forever I also give my Brother John Bowles One hundred and Twenty five acres land lying in Hanover County Virginia on Blackshaw and Mare and Saddle to him his Heirs and Assigns forever I also constitute and appoint John Bowles and Rubin Ford Executors of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and Seal this 30th Day of April in One Thousand seven hundred and eighty.
