it hath been please God to bless me in this life with a small
Estate which I would Dispose of in the following Manner -
First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Bond
One feather bed and furniture and all the whelp & and one
And her Increase to her for ever and all the rest of My Estate
I leave to my wife as long as she lives and after my wife's
Death all that I have I give to my son John Bond to him
And his heirs forever Except Twenty pounds prebentation
Money & that I give to my son Jesse Bond when My son John
Bond comes of Age And that to be paid in stock to be valued
by the Executors and the Improvement that I live on when the land
Office is open if there should be a chance of obtaining a right
That the money is to be raised out of John Bond's Estate to pay
the rights of the law and then the land to be equally Divided
Between my two sons Jesse Bond and John Bond Jesse to
have the upper part and John to have the lower part to them
And their heirs forever - I give and bequeath to
My two grandsons - Allen Westerd Bond and Robert Nicholas
Bond Two hundred acres of land lying on Mantaway river
In Albemarle County Virginia the land including the plan-
tation whereon my son Rutley Bond formerly lived to them and
their heirs forever -
