David Davis of Surry County North Carolina, Planter being weak in body but of sound memory blessed be god: do this 15th day of October in the year of our Lord 1782 make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following that is to say first I give to my son Daniel Davis his share of three breeding mares and also to my grand daughter Hannah Davis one cow. Also I give to my Elizabeth Davis the ~~Remainder~~ of my worldly Substance. During her Natural life, and at her death all her one Disposal as she think proper. and also after my decease my part of a mill on red bank I leave to my son Daniel Davis In Witness Whereof I the said David Davis have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above Written sign sealed and Delivered by the said David Davis as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us were present at the signing and stating thereof—
