Hets, two spinning wheels, three Jugs and glass bottles, one Lanthorn, one hand saw, one foot adze, one drawing knife, four Augers, one house five hog heads, three casks, four winter pails, eight pieces of earthen ware, one Looking glass, and three mortar one arm Chair, four books, one pair of candle snuffers, one grind stone, two pair of cards, one brush by the one pair, sheep shears.
