province of North Carolina being in perfect mind and memory
thanks be given unto God, for his mercies, do dispose of my
worldly estate as followeth.

I give dispose & bequeath unto my beloved brother Robert Turner
all my lands to be enjoyed by him and his heirs forever after
the decease of my father and mother; but during their living
they are to live on and enjoy the same at their pleasure without
any interruption. And I give & bequeath unto my well
beloved brother Robert Turner a Negro boy named George &
all the rest of my effects to be equally divided amongst
my other brothers and Sisters. Nominating and appointing
my brother Robert Turner my sole executor of this my last
will & testament; And I do hereby utterly make void all former
wills by me made, ratifying this and no other to be my
last will & testament. This sixth day of May 1769.
