this day being the sixteenth day of August and in the year
of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and eighty five do
make and publish this my last Will & Testament in man-
ner & form following, First I bequeath to my beloved wife Ann
Dickerson all my real & personal estate both land & movea-
bles during her natural life or widowhood to be kept together
for the support of herself and the raising my small children, and
after her decease or second marriage, I give said estate to my four
youngest children named William, Nathaniel, Matthew, & Jeremiah
to be equally divided betwixt them, except to David Dickerson
Milly, Susanna, Penelope, Nancy, Sarah & Griffith Dickerson, who
I give one Shilling ^{each of} them and I hereby make ordain James
Gaines my Executor & my wife Ann Dickerson Executrix for this
