given to god, do make and ordain my last will and Testament, at the follow-
ing manner and form to wit.

First I Recommend my soul into the hands of my God and Redeemer
Jesus Christ who gave it, and my body unto the Earth therein to be buried
in a Decent and Christian manner, and as Touching my worldly Estate,
where with it has Pleas'd god to bless me with in this world, I Distribute
Divide and dispose of the same at the following manner and form,
Secondly, it is my Absolute will and order, that all my debts where I am
Justly indebted shall be paid off out of my Estate, and on the other side
all my Just debts Credits and Demands in any wise Justly Due to me
shall be demand'd in by my hereafter named Executors, Thirdly it is my
Will and order that my beloved wife Hannah Houser shall have one
third part of all my real and Personal Estate according to the Valuation
thereof, and the other two third parts shall be divided amongst my
Children share & like, Fourthly I nominate ordain constitute and
appoint Michael Houser Jun^r and Jacob Miller Jun^r to be the
Executors of this my last will and Testament and utterly revoke
and annul all other and former wills and Testaments, Ratifying and
confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my seal this
