being in reasonable Health and of sound Disposing
Senses and Memory thanks be to the Almighty for
the same but considering the frailty of mans nature
and that there is an appointed time for all men once
to die do make this my last will and Testament,
that is to say first and foremost I Recommend
my soul into the hands of all Almighty God who
gave it me and my Body to the Earth to be decent-
ly Buried After the Direction of my Executors here-
after mentioned my will and desire is that all my
worldly Debt, and funeral expences be first paid
and discharged, and as for the Residue of what
worldly Goods it hath pleased Almighty God to be-
stow upon me I give and bequeath as followeth
my Will and Desire is that my beloved wife Mary
Hudspeth should have the use of the plantation where
on I now live with her Choice of two of my Horse Cattle
together with all my Cattle Hogs Moveable Estate in
General during her Widowhood I give &
bequeath to my son Ralph one Entry of Land lying
on the North fork of Deep Creek containing 640 Acres
one tract of land containing 640 Acres whereon
Frederick Long now lives I give and bequeath
to my son David the plantation where on I now
live containing 600 Acres after my wife Widowhood
the Land that is now in the hands of my Brother

Brother David Hudspeth which was Entered in his name
of the Ridge path that leads to Henry Waggoners cont-
-aining the Acres to be Equally Divided Between my
Daughters Lucy and Catharine, one Entry of Land
containing 200 Acres, and at the expiration of my
wife's Widowhood all my Movable Estate to be Equally
Divided Between my Children, my Desire is that my
Executors should give all my Children good learning
out of my Estate, and do constitute and appoint my
Brother David Hudspeth my Brother Gibson Woodbridge
and Col. Joseph Williams, Executors of this my last
Will and testament and do hereby Revoke Revoke
and make Void all former Wills by me heretofore
-made of Spokenoff. Wrote by my own hand this the 2^d.
day of June 1780. and affixed my own seal to it,

and have it Equally Divided a Greecable to my Will,
A.B. My will and Desire is that my Negro Wench be
sold and the Money Arising from that Sale I give

Horse breeders to be sold and the Money Arising
from that Sale, I give and bequeath to my son John
