God doth make this my last will and testament, as
followith, I give and bequeath to my Brother Nicolas
Hartless one hundred and twenty Acres of Land when
he the said Nicolas do arrive to the age of twenty one
years old, I give to my Bro^r James one hundred &
Twenty Acres of Land it being the remainder of the
above said tract when he do arrive to the age of one
and twenty years it is my will and Desire that all

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all the rest of my Estate should be sold and the money
Equally Devidid Between my two Brothers Named
above, when they should arrive to the Age of one and
twenty year, I do constitute my friend John Wright
and Samuel Arnold Executors to this my last will
and Testament in witness whereof I have set my
hand and affixed my Seal this 14th day of June
1781.
