Sixthly I will that those who shall carry my Corpse to the Burying ground shall have Twelve shillings to be Divide among them share and share alike - Seventhly as to the remainder of my Estate I will that my Other Three <sup>dear</sup> Children Valentin Hieronimus & Christina shall have the same Dividing it among Themselves share and share alike at the same time revoking all And any will Or wills by me heretofore Made In witness whereof I the said Margaretha Linn to this my last will and Testament have set My hand and seal this 28 day of August in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and seventy One
