two negroes named Dinah and Isaac which said Isaac
is a Boy Together with all my working tools and utensils
of husbandry and four hundred and fifty acres of Land
whereon I live together with all within and without doors
about the same, Nevertheless I will and require that if
my wife Judith shall live with her two youngest viz,
William and Ede on my said plantation that she shall
have an Equal share of the profits arising therefrom
for her maintenance During the term of her Widowhood
and I do hereby utterly Disallow revoke and Disannul all
and every other former Testaments Wills and Legacies require
and Executors by me in any wise before this time named
Willed and Bequeathed Ratifying and confirming this &
no other to be my Last will and Testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Day and
Year first above Written,
