mind the mortality of mankind and that is appointed
me for all men to die and being in perfect sense and
memory, do make this my last Will and Testament. —

First, I give my body, to the earth from whence it came
and my soul to God who gave it; And as for things
world goods, that it hath pleased God to bless me with.

I give and bequeath in manner and form following:
I give to my wife Margel Gitting negroes, Rale, Nelson,
Bot, Noarch, Sam, Sarah, together with my household
furniture, stock, plantation and working tools during
her natural life. After her decease to be dispose of
as followeth to wit, first I give and bequeath to my
brother Roger Gitting five pounds to him & his heirs
forever, — Item I give and bequeath to Nephews Francis
Gitting, William Gitting & Edward Gitting five pounds
a piece to them and their heirs. —

Item; I give and bequeath to my brother James Gitting
and his male heirs five pounds a piece to them
and their heirs forever. —

Item; I give & bequeath to Sarah Griffith five pounds
to her and her heirs forever. —

Item; I give and bequeath to my brother Edwards three
daughters Susanna, Martha, and Agnes three
dollars a piece. —

daughter Susanna, Martha & Ann three dollars a piece.
Then; after my lawfull debts are paid the within
legacies paid off I give and bequeath to my wife
Margel Gitting all the residue of my estate of
what property or denomination soever to her
disposal forever. I do constitute & appoint
Hugh Amstrong & Robert Harris to execute this
my last will and testament revoking & disanuling
all wills heretofore made by me.
