year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four
I Samuel Green being weak in body but in perfect mind
and memory, thanks be to God for the same and calling to
mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed
for all men to die; I commend my soul to God who gave it
and my body to the earth to be buried in a christian decent
manner according to the direction of my will; And as
touching my worldly estate, I order all my just debts and
funeral charges be paid. I then I give unto my husband
wife

the rent of my land during her lifetime or as long as she
remains my widow. 2 Item, I give unto my son John Guin
five shillings starting and no more. Item 3. After my wife
death or widowhood, let my land be sold, and divide the
money that it sells for between my other four sons: Samuel
Nathaniel, Foster and William; and my moveable estate
after my debts is paid to be divided equally between nine
children, Samuel, Nathaniel, Foster, Andrew & William and
Rebekah, Susannah, Jean, Margot & Isabella. And this
writing I affirm to be my last will and testament. In witness
whereof I hereunto set my hand and Seal the day and year
first above written. I desire my wife & Potentia Reese to
be my Executors. I order my executors to bind my son William
to some good trade, if they think fit.
