one Negro Girl Namely Agg with one half my stock of
Horses and all my neat Cattle sheep hogs and House
hold furniture also one hundred and fifty Acres of
Land adjoining my son Hugh Armstrong, Item,
I give and bequeath to my son in Law John Childrez
the other half of my stock of Horses Item my Will &
Desire is that my part of my Brothers John Armstrong
Estate be Equally Divided between John Childrez William
Armstrong Dillion Blevins and Mumford Smith
Item I give and bequeath to my son in Law James
Spencer five shillings, my Will and Desire is that if
my son William Armstrong should die before he
marries any Heir that his part above mentioned should
be Equally Divided between John Childrez Dillion Blevins
and Mumford Smith Item I do lastly constitute nomi-
-nate and appoint John Childrez and William Armstrong
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. In Witness
