And ~~the~~ mortality of my Body and knowing that it
is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this
my last will and Testament that is to say principally and
first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the Hand
of Almighty God who gave it and my Body I recommend
to the Earth to be Buried in Decent Christian Burial
at the Discretion of my Father Giles Hudspeth whom I
Constitute and Ordain the Sole Executor of this my last
Will and Testament and as touching such Worldly Estate
where with it has pleased God to Bless me in this life I
Give and Dispose of the Same unto Benjamin Hudspeth
and Charles Hudspeth my Two younger Brethren to be
Equally Divided Between them and in case they or either
of them should Die without issue then his or their parts
herein mentioned I will to return to my Father and I do
Ratify and Confirm this and no other to be my last Will
and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my
Hand and Seal this fourth Day of March in the year of
our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight

I have Given to my Son Henry who lives in this County & William
(and Robert ^{Ward} in Rute County) £ 27. 10 (Currency) of this
Province which they have Received -
I have Given and Bequeath to my Son John Ward the sum
of £ 27. 10 of such like money as above & Two Cows &
Calves for him the said John to receive at the age of 21
years & all the Residue of my Estate I leave to my Beloved
wife Mary During her Natural Life or Widowhood and
after to be Equally Divided amongst all my Children to
wit) Ann Elizabeth Mary Sarah William Henry Robert
& John.
