Nov. 12th 1875.

In the name of God. Amen.

I, Beedy A. Green of the County of Union and State of North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say

First: that my Executors herein after named shall provide for my Body a decent Burial, suitable to the wishes of my Relations and friends and pay all funeral Expenses together with my just Debts howsoever and to whomsoever owing out of the money, that may first come into their hands as a part or parcel of my Estate.

Item 2nd I Give and bequeath to my eldest Daughter Beedy E. Green now intermarried with M. C. Hugler, One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars when she becomes of age.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah J. Green, single Woman, One Hundred and twenty five Dollars, to be paid to her when she becomes of age, also One Bed and furniture that she now claims and so understood by the family, to have at my death the said Bed.

Item 4th I Give and bequeath to my youngest Daughter Lydia A. Green One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars when she becomes of age, Also one Bed and furniture to have at my death.

and declare this my last Will and Testament. in manner and form following; that is to say

First: that my Executors herein after named shall provide for my Body a decent Burial, suitable to the wishes of my Relations and friends and pay all funeral Expenses together with my just Debts howsoever and to whomsoever owing out of the money, that may first come into their hands as a part or parcel of my Estate.

Item 2nd I Give and bequeath to my eldest Daughter Beady E. Green now intermarried with M. C. Hugler, One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars when she becomes of age.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah J. Green, single Woman, One Hundred and twenty five Dollars, to be paid to her when she becomes of age, also One Bed and furniture that she now claims and so understood by the family, to have at my death the said Bed.

Item 4th I Give and bequeath to my youngest Daughter Lydia A. Green One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars when she becomes of age, Also one Bed and furniture to have at my death.

Item 5th I Give and bequeath to John B. Green, Aaron E. Green my two Step Sons and my three sons J. L. Green, Henry J. Green and William J. Green, the remainder of

all of my Interest in Land property. to be equally divided between them.

Item 6th I Give and bequeath to John B. Green Aaron C. Green my Step sons, James I. Green Henry T. Green and William T. Green The remainder of all my personal property to be equally divided between them. Giving my Executors the privilege of selling it at private sale in two years after my death and so settled with my Guardian first allowing my Executors to reserve enough money and provisions to carry out this present years Crop. and for it to be disposed of as the above personal property and accounted for as the above.

Item 7th And whereas my youngest son Wm T. Green, the said is a minor of about the age of Fourteen and will not be of the full age of Twenty one until the 7th day of December 1882. and my youngest Daughter Lydia A. Green will not arrive at the full age of Twenty one years until July the 9th 1885. And whereas my Eldest son James I. Green will not be of Age the full age of Twenty one until September the 3rd 1879. Now therefore my Will and desire is that my Step son John B. Green is hereby constituted and appointed Guardian of the said Wm T. Green and Lydia A. Green.

until the 7th day of December 1882. and my youngest Daughter Lydia A. Green will not arrive at the full age of Twenty one years until July the 9th 1885. And whereas my eldest son James L. Green will not be of Age the full age of Twenty one until September the 3rd 1879. Now therefore my Will and desire is that my Step son John B. Green is hereby constituted and appointed Guardian of these my Three Children, to have and to hold the custody and Guardianship both of their respective persons and Estates until they the said Wm J. Green Lydia A. Green and James L. Green shall severally arrive at the full age of Twenty one years.

Item 8th And whereas my Daughter Sarah J. Green will not arrive at the full age of Twenty one until February the 14th 1878. And whereas my son Henry J. Green will not arrive at the full age of Twenty one years of age until February the 26th 1881. Now therefore my Will and desire is that my Step son Aaron E. Green is hereby constituted and appointed Guardian of these my Two Children to have and to hold the custody and Guardianship both of their respective persons and Estates until they the said Sarah J. Green and Henry J. Green shall severally arrive at the Age full age of Twenty one years old.

Beedy A. Green Will concluded,
 And Lastly: I do hereby constitute and appoint my
 trustee friends John B. Green and Aaron E. Green. my
 Lawful Executors to all intents and purposes to Execute
 this my last Will and Testament, acknowledging according
 to the true intent and meaning of the same and verifying
 part and ~~for~~ ^{thereof} hereby Revoking and declar-
 ing utterly void all other Wills and Testaments by
 me heretofore made in witness whereof I the said Beedy
 A. Green do hereunto set my hand and seal, this the
 12th day of March, 1875.
