- 2nd I will and bequeath to my sister Jane Wilson children that is living Five Dollars a piece viz to Hugh and William Wilson and Susanah Norwood.
- 3rd I will and bequeath to my brother James H. Bellue Five Dollars
- 4th I will and bequeath to Martha L. Lowe, one bed and furniture as a compensation for her service while living with me
- 5th I will and bequeath to my brother Stephen Bellue all the rest of my estate consisting of Household and Kitchen Furniture, Grain and Stock of all descriptions and one team and its implements
- 6th I appoint my Brother Stephen Bellue my executor
