Enoch Griffins Last Will & Testament

In the name of God Amen. I Enoch Griffin of the County
of Union and State of North Carolina being of sound
mind and memory and Considering the uncertainty
of this Life do therefore make Ordain publish and
declare this to be my last Will & Testament.

1st That is to say after all my lawful debts are paid and
discharged the residue of my Estate real and personal
I give bequeath and dispose of as follows to wit
To My beloved son James C. Eighty acres of Land it
being a part of the tract on which I now live on the Eastern
part of said tract.

Also to my son Emory M. the residue of the said
tract which is Eighty seven acres being the Western part
of said tract.

Item 1 To James C. I will and bequeath the Speculator Horse and Fifty Dollars which he owes me, One Cow and Calf, from my Stock of Cattle, One Half of my Stock of Hogs One Bed and furniture also One Saddle.

" 2 To Emily M. I will and bequeath my Gray Horse and a Note of Fifty Dollars on Dr P. P. Sherman, and other One Cow and Calf from my Stock of Cattle One Half of my Stock of Hogs One Bed and furniture also one Saddle.

" 3 To Mary C. I will and bequeath one Choice Bed and furniture One Choice Cow and Calf One Hallen leaf Table One Chest Three Choice Chairs also one Saddle.

" 4 To Francis S. I will and bequeath one Choice Bed and furniture One Choice Cow and Calf One Bureau, One Kitchen Cupboard Three Choice Chairs also one Saddle and Five Dollars to have it repaired.

I will and bequeath that Corn to the Amount of Fifty five Dollars be sold out of my present Crop in order that it and a certain note on Dr P. P. Sherman, and other may defray a certain Note which Thomas B. Griffin holds against me for Eighty five Dollars. I further will and bequeath that the Corn and wheat now on hand and my growing Crop of wheat be equally divided among my four children.

I further will that they have five Dollars each
I further will that my farming utensils shall stay
on the premises for the use and benefit of my two
Sons James C. & Emily M. The remainder of my
House hold and Kitchen Furniture to be divided
equally divided between my two Daughters Mary
& Francis S.

Therefore I make constitute and appoint my Son Thomas B.
and James C. to be Executors of this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking all former Wills by me made
