

Last Will & Testament of Geo. M. Baker.

In the name of God, Amen.

I, George M. Baker of the County of Union and State of North Carolina, being in health of body and sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make this my Last Will and Testament. In manner and form following that is to say.

1st That my Executor hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my relatives and friends and pay all funeral expenses, together with my just debts howsoever and to whomsoever owing, out of the moneys that may first come into her hands as a part or parcel of my estate.

Item 2nd I give and devise to my beloved wife Mary Baker Thirty two acres of land lying in the County of Union State of N.C. situate

on the waters of Lanes Creek and adjoining the lands of Delphia Belk, E. L. Smith and others it being the tract whereon I now live together with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging to her her heirs and assigns forever, also all of my personal property and choses in action of what kind or nature so ever, and wherever the same shall be at my death.

And I do nominate and constitute and appoint my said wife sole executrix of this my last Will and testament hereby revoking and making void all and every other will or wills at any time heretofore made by me and to declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
