the State of North Carolina & County of Union, being
weakly in body but in sound mind & memory do make
this my last will & testament, I term the first I give & be-
queath to my wife Pheba Stegall that part of the land on
the north side of branch & household & furniture her life
& then to belong to my son Jeeze Stegall, & the other side of
branch on the south land side to belong to my son Thomas
Stegall, But I want all my just debts paid, & all the stock
& mares waggon & cart & working too Phebe his wife as long
as she lives if any thing left then to be sold & equally divided
amongst all his children also that Asa Helms my only friend
be my executor; whereof I set my hand & seal. Signed sealed &
delivered in the presence of us this the 6th of November 1845
