

Last Will of H. M. Doster.

State

I, H. M. Doster, of Monroe, Union County, Mo. Co., being of sound mind and reason, make this my last will & Testament do hereby dispose all of my property I now hold or may hereafter acquire, in the following manner.

I bequest to my daughters Lula Fincher, Mary Helen all of my property in real estate and all the personal property with exception of my trunk, which I will to William Little to be given him immediately after my death. The other property described above is to be given to my daughters named above under the following conditions.

The rents and income from the property is to pay all legal debts that may be against me, and the balance is to be put at interest to be held until the youngest girl becomes of age, at which time it shall be equally divided between the girls named above. The East end of the house and lot on which I now live I bequest to Lula Fincher. The house situated at the rear of C. M. E. Church I give to my daughter Mary Helen. I bequest to Katty, my wife, a home in the S part of house where I now live to be held for her as long as
