Jacob Wolf last will & Testament

February the 14th 1851.

I Jacob Wolf of the County of Union and State of North Carolina being of sound sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to

say

First that my executor here in after named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my friends and to pay all my funeral expences together with my Just debts if there be any out of the first moneys that may come into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate

2nd I give and devise to my beloved wife Rachael all of the lands I now possess to have and to hold to her the said Rachael for and during the term of her natural life

3rd I also give and devise to my said beloved wife Rachael my negro woman named Liza and two Beds

Jacob Wolf's will to out of
 and furniture her choice one Cupboard one table her choice
 and as much house hold and kitchen furniture as she may
 need also my family Bible and such other of my Books
 as she may choose also my family Carriage and harness and
 my sweet mule let two Cows & Calves her choice five sheep her
 choice five Hogs her choice also one sow and pigs all the
 domestick fowls and poultry also one years provision

4th My will and desire is that all the residue of my estate
 after taking out the devises and legacies above mentioned shall
 be sold and the debt owing to me collected and the surplus
 over and above the payments of debts expenses and legacies
 that such surplus shall be equally divided and paid over
 to my said wife and all of my children in equal proportion
 with the exception of those of my children who have rec^d
 advancements in my lifetime they shall not reciv an equal
 proportion over and above what they have received un-
 till those of my children who have not had advanci-
 ments shall have received the same amount that the
 others have received

5th My will and desire is my lands and all other proper-
 ty that my said wife shall be in possession of until

3th My will and desire is my lands and all other proper-
ty that my said wife shall be in possession of at the time
of her death shall be sold and the moneys arising there-
from to be equally distributed amongst all of my children

6th My will is that my daughter Elizabeth who is dead
and was the wife of George Howie shall draw an equ-
al proportion with the rest of my children and her part
to be equally distributed amongst her bodily heirs

excuse this my last will and testament according
to the true intent and meaning of the same and ev-
ery part and clause thereof hereby revoking and de-
claring utterly void all other wills and testaments
by me here before made
