as my last will and testament:

My main purpose in making this will is to preserve and

and accomplish the said main purpose, I direct that the

owner to sell, buy, exchange, lease, hire or give in her discretion

his or her majority, or marriage, such portions of my estate
as she can spare, provided sufficient is retained to make the
shares of the other unportioned children equal to those advanced

heretofore made by me.
