I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy E. Hasty Twenty Dollars, to be hers and at her disposal absolutely forever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha A. Tucker Twenty Dollars, to be hers and her disposal absolutely forever.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary J. Bell Twenty Dollars, to be hers and at her disposal absolutely forever.

I give and bequeath to my Son P. N. Horn all the tract of land whereon he now lives, to have and to hold to to him and his heirs, and at his disposal absolutely forever: and I further give and bequeath to said Son all my other property that remains after my executor pays all my just debts to whomever owing and also to said Son all my notes and accounts, to be his and his heirs in fee simple forever.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son P. N. Horn my lawful executor to all intents and purposes, to execute this my last will and Testament, according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part & Clause thereof.
