James Mills' Last Will and Testament.

I know all men by these Presents. That I James Mills of the County of Union
in the State of North Carolina being of sound disposing mind and memory
do make and publish this my last Will and Testament:

- 1st I give and devise to my son Sydney the tract of land on which
he now resides known as a part of the Lowry land - bounded by the
lands of H. S. Lee - J. H. Evans and my own land - situate in the
County of Union State of North Carolina - Containing Forty acres
more or less: To have and to hold the same to him the said Sydney
Mills and his heirs and assigns forever.
- 2nd I give and devise to my son Wheeler, his heirs and assigns the tract
of land where on he settled. Forty acres situate on the Eastern side
of the tract I now live on, to include the house built for the said Sydney
Mills - situate in the County and State aforesaid: To have and to hold the same.
- 3rd I give and devise to my son Patrick, that part of my land on which
he resides, to commence or to include the cotton patch on the public road and
joining the Timmons land - also to include the house in which he lives now -
all lines to be straight - not to include - bottom lands of Brown Creek, to
contain, Sixty five acres, To have and to hold the same to him the
said Patrick Mills his heirs and assigns forever.
- 4th I have given to my son Albert One hundred acres of land on
which he now resides, in consideration of which he is not here given
or devised any other part of my Real Estate.
- 5th I have heretofore given to my son Charles a tract of land bounded

contain, Sixty five acres, To have and to hold the same to him the
said Patrick Mills his heirs and assigns forever.

4th I have given to my son Albert One hundred acres of land on
which he now resides, in consideration of which he is not here given
or desired any other part of my Real Estate.

5th I have heretofore given to my son Charles - a certain tract or parcel
of land in Chesterfield County State of South Carolina, Deed to the
same having been previously made to him - it is not my desire to give or
desire unto him any other part or parcel of my Real Estate.

6th I give and devise to my beloved wife Nancy the rest and residue of the
tract of land lying on the East side of the Public road - to have and to
hold as long as she shall remain unmarried and my widow - but on
her decease or marriage the said remainder thereof I give and devise
to my son Thomas To have and to hold the same to him the said
Thomas Mills and his heirs and assigns forever. Also I give and
devise to my wife Nancy upon the same conditions as before stated - the
tract of land known as the orchard field which all lands occupied
by fruit trees and in cultivation on the West side of the aforesaid Public road - on
her decease or marriage I give and devise the same to my son Thomas.

7th I give and devise to the heirs at law of my deceased daughter Adeline
Hendrick and my daughters Maggie Mills and Jane Rape the remainder of
the tract of land lying and being on the West of the Orchard field - and
their heirs respectively to be divided in equal shares between them -
my daughter Maggie to have the most easterly share of lot. The

- children of my deceased daughter to have only the part to which their mother would be entitled to of living
- 8th I give and devise to my four sons viz Sydney, Patrick Wheeler & Thomas, all the bottom lands on Brown creek containing Fifty two acres more or less to be divided in equal shares between them except as to Thomas who I wish to have twelve acres of the aforesaid fifty two acres
- 9th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy all my household furniture and all the rest and residue of my personal property after payment of my debts and funeral expenses as long as she shall remain unmarried & my widow - on her decease or marriage to go to my son Thomas.
- 10th I ordain and appoint my wife Nancy Mills as Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal and publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in the presence of the Witnesses named below this the eighth day of July A. D. One thousand eight hundred and ninety one
