 my estate more than they have already received. After
 my death I want my Executor to sell all my little per-
 sonal property for cash and add the amount of sale to
 the balance of my estate which consists in in money
 in solvent hands and divide I want all my children
 (except those excluded) or their legal representatives to
 be equal sharers in my estate except my son A. Brown
 whom I will shall have twice as much or double
 what any one of the other legatees receive. I give to
 my poor Niece four times as much in money as
 one of the other girls for her care & trouble with me.
 As soon as convenient after my death I want my ex-
 ecutor to close up the estate and divide out
 I hereby constitute and appoint my dearly
 beloved son-in-law J. D. A. Secret my executor
 of this my last will Given under my hand

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day of July, 1891, that the said Jeremiah Neutz did at the time of subscribing his name as aforesaid declare the said paper writing to be his Last Will and Testament, and that he did thereupon subscribe his name at the end of said Will as an attesting witness thereto and at the request and in the presence of the said testator, that at the time the said testator subscribed his name to the said Last Will as aforesaid, and at the time he subscribed his name as a witness thereto, the said Jeremiah Neutz was of sound mind and memory, of full age to execute a Will, and was not under any restraint to the knowledge, information or belief of the deponent. It is therefore adjudged that the said paper writing and every part and clause thereof is the Last Will and Testament of Jeremiah Neutz, deceased, and ordered that the same be recorded and that Letters Testamentary be issued to J. D. A. Secrest, the Executor therein named, who thereupon takes the oath required by law and Letters Testamentary are issued to him.
