

Kindric Richardson last will & testament

I Kindric Richardson of Union County in the State of North Carolina being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and establish the following to be my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills by me heretofore made

Item 1st I will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of any money that may come into the hands of my executor herein after named

Item 2^d I will and devise to my grand son Foster Richardson my plantation lying on the head waters of Big Lynches Creek containing about one hundred and twenty five acres more or less adjoining Jackson Griffin Lipe Bultelton & James Wilson to have and to hold to him and his heirs in fee simple absolutely forever

Item 3^d I will and devise to my son General Kindric Richardson all the balance of my real estate consisting of the home tract on which I now live containing about three hundred acres and a half of one hundred acres more or less adjoining Jacob Starnes Kiram Brown & Mrs P. Richardson to have and to hold to him and his heirs in fee simple absolutely forever and I further will and bequeath to my said son General Kindric Richardson all my personal estate consisting of money notes stock of all descriptions farming tools and house hold and kitchen furniture crops of all kinds and of every nature & description whatsoever of my personal estate to hold as his absolute property forever

- Item 4th I will to my son Mason Richardson five dollars
- Item 5th I will to my daughter Mahala Medlen wife of Perry Medlen five dollars
- Item 6th I will to my daughter Vinny widow of Melvin Harnes dec'd five dollars
- Item 7th I will to Caroline wife of Fincher Richardson five dollars
- Item 8th I will to Abigail widow of Giles Helms dec'd five dollars
- Item 9th I will to Franky wife of Jackson Harnes five dollars
- Item 10th I will to my daughter Claripa wife of Burton Fincher five dollars
- Item 11th I will to the children of my daughter Lucy Kopp five dollars to be divided between them equally
- Item 12th My wife Jane having left my bed and board without any sufficient ^{cause} ~~for~~ I do not desire that she shall have any portion of my estate real, or personal, or mixed
- Item 13th I do hereby lastly appoint my son General Kinderie Richardson the executor of this my last will and testament and reversionary legatee of all my property not disposed of in the above will

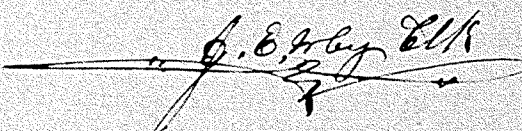
