State of North Carolina Union County I in the name
of God amen. I Lydia Finchier widow in & of the County
& State aforesaid being low in health & weak of body
but of strong mind & memory do declare this to be my
last will & testament. <sup>1st I resign my soul into the
hands of Almighty God who gave it. 2nd I con-
sign my body to mother earth to be interred in a decent
& Christian like manner, and as to my worldly property
which it pleased God to bestow on me I do hereby
dispose of in the following (viz) First I will & put in trust
into the hands of my son Silas A. Finchier all of my landed
estate containing (194) one hundred & ninety four acres together
with the domicie & all rights members & hereditamently and
appurtenances belonging for use, behoof, benefit & advantage of
my son James E. Finchier for & during the term of his the said James
E. Finchiers natural life & at & after the death of him the said
James E. Finchier then the said land together with all the right
members, hereditaments & appurtenances, remains & reversions
to descend go to & remain unto my son Silas A. Finchier his heirs &
assigns forever. Further I do will & put in trust into the hands
of my son Silas A. Finchier for use behoof, benefit & advantage of
my said son James E. Finchier for & during the term of the natural</sup>

& Christian like manner, and as to my worldly property
which it pleased God to bestow on me I do hereby
dispose of in the following (viz) First I will & put in trust
into the hands of my son Silas A. Finscher all of my landed
estate containing (194) one hundred & ninety four acres together
with the dwelling & all rights members & hereditaments and
appurtenances belonging for use, behoof, benefit & advantage of
my son James E. Finscher for & during the term of his the said James
E. Finschers natural life & at & after the death of him the said
James E. Finscher, then the said land together with all the right
members, hereditaments & appurtenances, remainders & reversions
to descend go to & remain unto my son Silas A. Finscher his heirs &
affiliis forever. Further I do will & put in trust into the hands
of my son Silas A. Finscher for use behoof, benefit & advantage of
my said son James E. Finscher for & during the term of the natural
life of him the said James E. Finscher, the following property viz one
negro man named Willis & one young boy more my present
crop of corn & fodder one good bed & bed furniture & all of my
house hold & kitchen furniture except three beds I also give
six fat hogs & one cow & calf & at & after the death of him the

said James E. Fincher all of the aforesaid chattels personal
to be sold & the proceeds to be equally divided between my
children Silas A. Fincher Eliza Howey, Permelia Howey &
Lydia Crane or their legal representatives.

Secondly I will & bequeath unto my daughter Lydia
Crane one negro girl All a for & during the term of her natural
life then to her bodily heirs but if the said Lydia Crane shall die
leaving no bodily issue, then the said negro girl shall be returned
to be sold & the proceeds equally divided among my legal heirs

Thirdly I will that all the residue of my estate consisting
of three beds & furniture, my part of the cotton crop, hogs
cattle & sheep & other articles not before disposed of, one negro
woman only be sold & after paying all my just debts the balance
to be equally divided between my two daughters Eliza Howey
& Permelia Howey.

Fourthly I will & bequeath unto my son James E. Fincher
twenty five bushels of wheat in addition to the aforesaid bequests
which wheat is to be taken out of the crop on hand.

Fifthly and lastly I do hereby constitute, nominate & appoint
my son Silas A. Fincher my lawful executor to see that this my
will is duly executed & performed, In witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand & affixed my seal this sixteenth day of October

Twenty five bushels of wheat in addition to the aforesaid bequests
which wheat is to be taken out of the crop on hand.

Fifthly and lastly I do hereby constitute nominate & appoint
my Son Silas A. Fincher my lawful executor to see that this my
will is duly executed & performed, In witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand & affixed my seal this sixteenth day of October
in the year of our Lord 1845.
