

Last Will & Testament of Peter Parker Dec'd
In the Name of God Amen.

I, Peter Parker of the County of Union
and State of North Carolina, Being of sound
mind and Memory but considering the un-
certainty of life and the certainty of death
do make this my last Will & Testament
in manner and form to wit, viz:
1st That after my death my Executor herein-
after named shall provide for my body
a decent burial suitable to the wishes
of my friends and pay off all Expenses
together with all my just debts out of
the money that may first come into
his hands as a part or parcel of my
Estate.

2^d My Will & Desire is that all my Estate
both real & personal I give and bequeath
to my wife Nancy Parker to have & to
hold for the use of herself & family
her life time & that my Executor sell
off such part of my personal Estate
as he thinks they can do without &

hold for the use of herself & family
her lifetime & that my Executor sell
off such part of my personal Estate
as he thinks they can do without &
apply the proceeds to the use of the family.
3^d My will & desire is that after the death
of my wife that my Executor sell off
all of my personal Estate & pay over to
my Daughter Susannah M. King the sum
of One hundred Dollars, above her equal
share, to make her equal with the rest
of my heirs with what I have given off
to them before.

4th My will & desire is what remains
of my personal Estate that my Executor
pay himself for his trouble & commisa-
sions & the rest for him to equally divide
amongst all my lawful heirs, those that
are owing me either by Note or Acct
to be charged with the same with Interest
in a final Settlement of my personal
Estate.

5th My Will & desire is I give & bequeath

 to my son Peter & Parker, a lot or parcel of
 land lying on James Creek, joining the Car-
 lock's lands embracing the house and
 plantation commencing on the bank of
 James Creek and runs with the old fence
 near the Camp branch to a spring near
 the ford on said branch up said branch
 to the corner of that old field, thence west
 up the old road to the Camden Road
 thence down said road to Carlock's
 line, thence with the various courses
 of sd line to James Creek, thence with
 said Creek to the Beginning to be his
 full share of all my real Estate.

6th My will is that the balance of my
 land be sold & equally divided amongst
 my lawful heirs.

7th My will is that my Executor herein
 after named do execute this will of his
 own judgment without brass expenses
 & sell & collect & pay over to my lawful
 heirs & debts & the rest.

7th My will is that my Executor herein
after named do execute this will of his
own judgment without brass expences
sell & collect & pay over to my lawful
heirs & take receipt for the same.

8th And lastly I do hereby appoint and
constitute my trusty friend & brother
J H Parker my Lawful Executor to exe-
cute this my last Will & Testament
to all intents & purposes herein named
hereby revoking and declaring all other
wills null & void and of no effect by
me here before made.
