I give to my Sister Rebecca Baker ^{Twenty} dollars - I give to my Step Sons Alexander Nisbet & John Nisbet each Twenty dollars -

I allow all my wearing apparel & clothing of every description & all my cupboard furniture to be divided among my Sisters Martha & Rebecca the two Daughters of my Brother Nathaniel & the two Daughters of my Brother Israel.

I give to my Step Son George A. Nisbet my walnut table & large Arm Chair - I give to my Step Daughter Nancy Nelson my Bed & Cupboard - I give to my Step Daughter Elizabeth Craig my Bureau & to her Daughter Sally my Saddle - my Bed - Stead, bed & all the bed clothing that is now at the house of James D. Craig -

I give to my Step Daughters, Nancy Nelson & Elizabeth Craig ^{my} - I give to nephew Alexander J. Davis my Walnut Chest.

And I do hereby appoint my Step Son Alex^r Nisbet Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
