Item the third, I will and desire, for the

Item the third, I will and desire, for the
reasons set forth in Item second of
this my last will & testament, that
my said son James H Polk be not
charged for any rents which may be
coming to me on account of his having
worked my lands, and I hereby will
and bequeath all such rents & profits
to my said beloved son, James H Polk.
Item the fourth, I hereby make and ap-
point my beloved son James H
Polk my sole executor.
