

Last Will & Testament of Sarah A. Pyron

I, Sarah A. Pyron do make and declare this my last will and testament as follows:
Item 1st I give and devise unto my husband Thomas R. Pyron the plantation upon which I now live together with all the personal property that I possess of whatsoever kind to his own use and support during his natural life.

Item 2nd I give and devise unto my sister M. Caroline Pyron the plantation upon which I now live to be hers, after the death of my husband, during her natural life then to her children.

Item 3^d I give unto my niece Cora Jane Pyron one bed & furniture, also to my sister M. C. Pyron one bed and furniture the one upon which I now am lying, I also give unto my niece Martha M. Pyron my Walnut bureau to be turned over to them after the death of my husband.

Item 4th I will and devise unto

Sarah A. Pyron one bed and furniture the one upon which I now am lying, I also give unto my niece Martha M. Pyron my Walnut bureau to be turned over to them after the death of my husband.

Item 4th I will and bequeath unto my husband T. R. Pyron any & all monies that may be due me from my mother's estate to his own use forever
