Item 1 I bequeath to my dear husband A. C. Russell the sum of Five hundred Dollars, out of my interest in the personal property which I am entitled to receive from the estate of my father A. M. Porter decd.

Item 2 I will and bequeath to my said husband A. C. Russell all the rest and residue of my interest in my said father's estate both real and personal upon the following terms and limitations viz My said husband shall have the use occupation and benefit of all of said property, and the rents, income and profits derived therefrom until our child Willie M. Russell shall reach the age of twenty one years, at which time I will and bequeath all of said property, real and personal, to our said son Willie M. Russell, and his heirs forever, and direct that my said husband shall at that time make settlement with our said son, and turn over to him all of the property disposed of by this item of my will except such rents, income and profits as shall accrued therefrom up to that period, which I direct shall belong to my said husband in his own right. 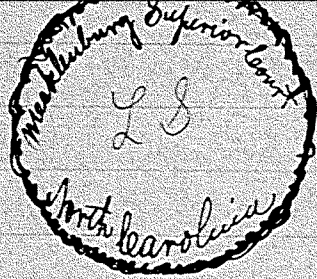
